- Today's Topic: **Compliance in a non-compliant culture**



It's peculiar. In recent weeks, in a variety of contexts, the word "compliance" has been a popular buzzword, from my dentist to prescription drugs, financial service marketing, and government regulations.

To comply = to agree or yield as to a wish or command

Compliance = acquiescence to a rule, request, demand; a tendency to yield to others

"I wrote to you as I did to test you and see if you would fully comply with my instructions."
1 Corinthians 2:9 (New Living Translation)

"But as soon as I saw that they were not straightforward and were not living up to the truth of the Gospel, I said to Cephas before everybody present, If you, though born a Jew, can live [as you have been living] like a Gentile and not like a Jew, how do you dare now to urge and practically force the Gentiles to comply with the ritual of Judaism and live like Jews?" Galatians 2:14 (Amplified Bible)

In more Biblical terms, "compliance" is another word for "obedience." So, I wonder today, do we have major compliance issues in our businesses today? If so, how?
